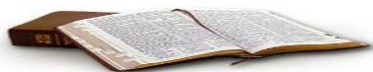

## The 2024 Catholic Charity Appeal is underway!

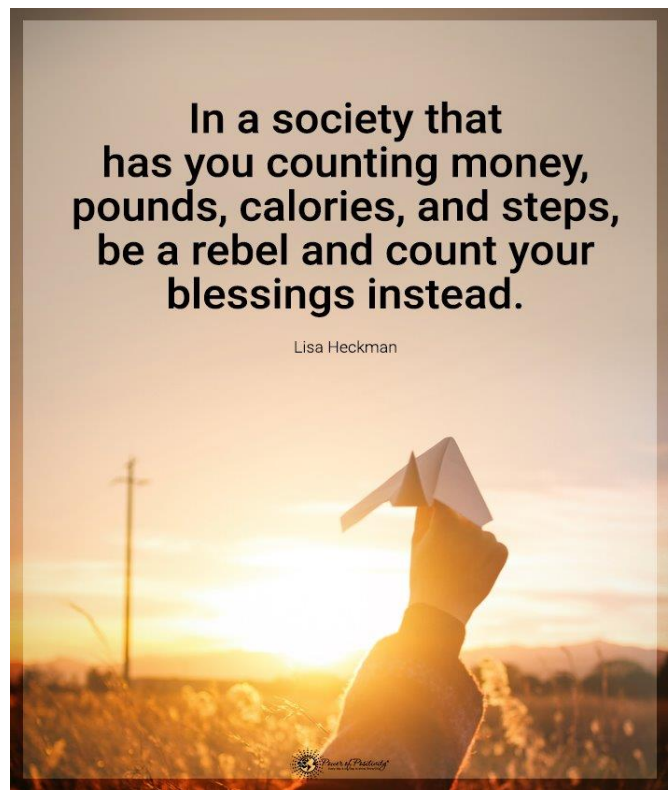
